As we unveil our two stunning new designs, we had the privilege of catching up with long-time Numarine collaborator, Can Yalman, who takes us behind the scenes of the creative process that shaped the Numarine 30XP and 40MXP.



What inspired the design of the new Numarine 30XP and 40MXP yachts?

CAN YALMAN: The Numarine 30XP and 40MXP yachts were inspired by the laid-back Mediterranean lifestyle, emphasizing open spaces, proximity to the sea, and relaxed outdoor living. The design seamlessly integrates the yacht's interiors with the surrounding environment, blending indoor and outdoor spaces harmoniously. Expansive deck areas provide ample room for relaxation, socializing, and alfresco dining, while panoramic windows enhance the breathtaking views of the Mediterranean coastline. Meticulous attention to detail, with handpicked materials and finishes reflecting coastal charm, creates a tranquil and welcoming atmosphere onboard, offering an authentic connection to the sea and outdoor environment.

What were some of the challenges you faced during the design process, and how did you overcome them?

REVOLUTIONARY FUTURE

The new Numarine 30XP is the first diesel-electric addition to its successful XP range of explorers, and is explicitly designed to gratify the shipyard's most demanding serial owners.

Numarine has marked its momentous 20th anniversary by introducing a groundbreaking addition to its esteemed range - the first-ever model equipped with diesel-electric propulsion. As the popularity of the 26XP and 32XP continues to soar, the 30XP strategically fills a void in Numarine's exceptional line-up. Already garnering significant interest, with three units sold, the construction of the molds is well underway, the first 30XP launched in May 2024.

The 30XP boasts impressive accommodations for ten guests across five lavish en suite staterooms, including a master stateroom on the main deck with panoramic floor-to-ceiling windows and innovative bulwark cut-outs, offering unparalleled sea views. An optional fold-down balcony enhances the master stateroom's allure.

Apart from the inviting main salon with full-height windows, the aft deck and covered sundeck offer delightful openair dining experiences, with customization options to suit individual owner preferences. Exhibiting ingenious design, the semi-open beach club at the stern features elevated headroom achieved by raising the deck above, creating a lounging area a mere three steps above the main deck. Boasting an expansive deck space expanding to 43 sqm, the beach club also features three fold-down platforms for added deck space and a convenient side-loading tender bay capable of accommodating a 6.25-meter tender.

Efficiency and style converge in the 30XP's raised pilothouse design, skillfully envisioned by Can Yalman. Adding to the allure, an expansive sun pad graces the foredeck, just ahead of the pilothouse, while the forward section of the lower deck provides comfortable accommodations for the five-member crew. Owners can tailor their yachting experience by choosing between two propulsion options - the diesel-electric system with Veth pod drives or the conventional drive train comprising twin 560-hp MAN engines.





The world is full of experiences just waiting to happen. The Numarine 32XP is an exceptional blend of size and capability, fully equipped and ready to take you on a journey anywhere you so desire.

The Numarine 32XP is the much-loved model of the highly acclaimed XP Series. Simplicity of use, engaging styling and the seamless integration of systems are key principles of the yacht. While being just under the limit of 300 GT category, she boasts incredible volumes of internal living spaces on board, with her steel hull and GRP superstructure allowed to create unique layouts internally and customized external spaces.

The exterior styling is by Can Yalman, who is the design partner of the brand. The 32XP silhouette is deliberately rugged, powerful and hefty, with extensive angular windows. Another contemporary feature added to the yacht is the vertical bow, which makes cutting through the water an easy feat. The hull's shape, designed by Numarine's longstanding collaborator, naval architect Umberto Tagliavini, is beneficial to the internal volumes.

The interior is also penned by Yalman. Like all Numarines, the interior of the 32XP is fully customizable to reflect the owner's preferences in terms of layout, design, fabrics and materials. There is a spacious main salon and several outside areas to socialize, including a large couch area with Bimini and cocktail table forward of the wheelhouse and a huge flybridge.

Including the master suite forward on the main deck, the 32XP has six cabins. A roomy VIP cabin opens up via sliding doors to the incredibly large open deck. In navigation, it can even fit a spectacular 9-meter RIB tender and two PWCs with the help of the 2.5 Tons crane. Four additional guest cabins are placed on the lower deck. Below deck forward, the 5-person crew quarters provide ideal spaces for the captain with his private cabin and ensuite, and four crew members in two doubles with ensuite.

The 32XP accommodates up to 12 guests and is ready for long cruises with her proven hull and ample storage facilities. With this exceptional model, sharing the experience of a lifetime has never been more pleasurable. Step out of the comfort range of your usual base and explore the world with the Numarine 32XP.

NUMARINE 37XP

STEERING FOR GREATNESS

Taking to the sea and welcoming the embrace of the elements means entering a magical world without bans or borders, limited solely by the imagination. With The Big Blue steeped in her DNA, the Numarine 37XP goes that extra mile.

The Numarine 37XP is one of the bigger sisters of the XP series. Born and built according to parameters that have kept the Numarine brand at the forefront of innovation and technology, the 37XP combines a refined, but easily recognizable aesthetic with an ambitiously conceived functionality to deliver a first-class experience.

Can Yalman penned the 37XP's exterior design, built on the same 8-meter beam as the 32XP but with a generous five extra meters of length. The lines on the 37XP are a refinement of the robust look of the 32XP with flowing, softer lines that accentuate the longer length and balance strength and elegance. Large windows provide ample natural light and are one of her standout features.

Constructed with a steel hull and FRP construction with superstructure, Umberto Tagliavini penned the yacht's naval architecture. How to Buy An Art Piece
For Your Yacht

How and based on what criteria will you purchase an artwork for your living space on the water? Here are a few tips to help you with your selection.

How did you first get into yachting? What was it like?



What are your top 5 drinks this summer and why?

KEVIN PATNODE: If I can cheat a bit, I'll share my five favorite things to drink all summer. When the temperatures rise in the Mediterranean, I generally crave light and easygoing drinks that will quench my thirst. I love natural wine and recently enjoyed some amazing whites from the beautiful Italian island of Pantelleria - they tell a story, respect the land and therefore the sea, and they just taste like summer. Otherwise, I'm guilty of enjoying a delicious Aperol Spritz, especially when cosplaying as an old Hollywood star traveling around Cote D'Azur - the drink is just perfectly balanced, especially when enjoyed with a splash of Campari. If I had a night out dancing under the stars, my go-to hangover cure is always an ice-cold Michelada, more refreshing and easier to make than a Bloody Mary. Simple drinks, a crispy Gin and Tonic with a squeeze of citrus and some fresh Aegean herbs will always hit the spot, or you can't go wrong with a Mezcal Margarita, which I prefer to a classic margarita, which somehow always go down too easily in the summer heat.

When it comes to cocktails inspired by the sea or coastal regions, what is your alltime favorite?

KP: I would have to say that any version of the spritz is my favorite sea-side cocktail because of its incredibly refreshing effect. A spritz, made up of any sort of Amaro or Liqueur, Sparkling Wine, and Sparkling Water, is just the perfect fusion of things that remind me of being close to the sea. The Amaros and liqueurs are reminiscent of long dinners with good friends, where bowls of pasta and seafood are devoured and finished off by a small shot of bitter liqueur to cap off the night. The sparkling wine, whether it be Prosecco, Champagne, or even Pet-Nat, is always going to be a symbol of celebration and the spirit of fun and freedom you get when you're by the water. And finally, a splash of fizzy water reminds you of the sea breeze or waves slowly crashing on the shore - it's refreshing in the best way.



Kevin's Recipe for the Perfect Med Cocktail

- ♦ 40 ml Gin, 20 ml Raki/Ouzo/Pastis
- ♦ 15 ml Lemon Juice
- ♦ 10 ml Honey
- ◆ I handful of Mint,
- ◆ 100 ml of Light Premium Tonic Water
- ◆ Lots of ice, and Voila!



Can you recommend a cocktail recipe that captures the essence of the Mediterranean coastline?

KP: If you're anywhere in the Mediterranean, you'll always be close to some sort of delicious Anise liqueur, whether that be Raki, Ouzo, or Pastis... While I love these on their own, I find they best play with crispy citrus flavors and can shine beautifully in a balanced cocktail. I like to shake these anise liqueurs with gin, Lemon, Honey, and Mint before topping with a light tonic water - everything just tastes like summer and the Mediterranean!

The coasts around the world offer a diverse array of cocktail traditions. Is there a specific coastal cocktail that you find particularly intriguing or enjoy making?

KP: When we think of coastal cocktails, we often think of summer and lighter drinks, but in the Northern seas of the world, especially in coastal regions of Scotland where some of my favorite Whisky is made, I enjoy the hotter cocktails a lot - which allow you to appreciate the seaside in the winter months as well. A well made hot-toddy, with tea, ginger, lemon, honey, and Scotch Whisky, is such a beautiful drink to sip and stay warm, even by the cold seaside.

If you were to create a cocktail that represents the experience of being on board, what flavors and ingredients would you include, and what would be the inspiration behind it?

KP: I think I would have to create a drink based on sparkling wine - the bubbles, the history and legacy of Champagne, just exudes the luxurious experience of being on a yacht. I would want to include fresh flavors as well to lighten the experience, such as basil or mint, giving the fresh feeling of a sea breeze to the cocktail. And finally, I would need to include some ripe, juicy, summer fruits - which always somehow taste better when enjoyed on a yacht. I think a sort of Bellini meets Aperol Spritz would be the creation - a celebration of luxury, the sea, and all the bounty that the Mediterranean provides.




Looking ahead, what personal aspirations or goals do you have for your own yachting adventures? Are there any dream destinations or specific experiences you hope to encounter?

MANAGING YOUR YACHT: Hiring the Perfect Crew

You are on your yacht. Maybe with your family, maybe with your friends, enjoying the serenity and freedom amidst the vast blue of nature's embrace. Everything is in order. How? Of course, thanks to your crew, who meticulously handle every detail, from the safety to the technical equipment of your yacht. Let's take a look together with Bahadır Şen, the General Manager of Marinbase Yacht Management, at what it takes to have the right crew for your yacht.





While onboard, enjoying the tranquility and freedom amidst the vastness of nature's embrace, having a well-chosen crew onboard becomes even more crucial. So to speak, it becomes twice as important. Let's explore the process of selecting the right crew for your private yacht and the criteria to consider.

Firstly, let's see the tasks that the crew will be responsible for onboard your yacht. Considering the two different scenarios when you are on the yacht and when you are not, the crew's responsibilities become clearer. Whether you are on board or not, there is a continuous 24-hour cycle of life on the yacht, and the crew's working hours are in effect around the clock. During this time, the crew's most important duty is to ensure the safety of the yacht, and consequently, your safety. Their primary task is to do everything possible to avoid various unfortunate events like fire, collision, man overboard, or any damage to the yacht. To accomplish this, the crew's training, courses, certifications, skills, experience, and composure are essential to prevent such situations from happening or to handle them efficiently if they do occur.

SAFE ROUTES

In case of an emergency onboard, until rescue and intervention teams like fire brigade or ambulance arrive, the crew will be the ones to rescue you, your family, and guests, provide first aid, and ensure a safe place to reach.

Moreover, while you are on board, the crew will also be responsible for providing a comfortable and peaceful experience for the guests. This includes general and custom cleaning of the yacht, preparing meals, hosting you and your guests, managing water sports equipment, and keeping them ready at all times. Additionally, routine checks of operating generators, watermakers, and other devices, as well as continuous hospitality and service, are part of their daily responsibilities. The number of these tasks may vary depending on the size of the yacht and its usage.

Considering that you spend 24 hours together with the crew while on the yacht, they will almost become like family to you.

When you are not onboard, the crew should maintain the work routine, including daily checks, maintenance, cleaning, and safety measures in the marina, harbor, or anchorage where the yacht is located. They may also have special tasks related to technical issues, repairs, maintenance, and preparations before or after the season, which can extend beyond regular working hours.

WHAT SHOULD YOU PAY ATTENTION TO WHEN SELECTING THE CREW?

Having a professional crew is crucial as they hold all the responsibility for your yacht, whether you are on board or not. All these roles mentioned above form a summary of their job description.

Let's take a look at the crew selection process. If you treat this process like hiring any regular employee, you will leave it to chance, and depending on your luck, you may encounter either good or bad results. First, besides the basic tasks listed above, you need to determine other tasks you want them to perform and the number of crew members required to fulfill these tasks. Each role requires a qualified individual. After determining the qualifications and number of crew members, you should review their CVs, certificates, and licenses. It is crucial to speak with their references and conduct face-to-face interviews with the candidates to ensure that the job descriptions are clearly understood, and all expectations and requests from the crew are carefully heard to avoid uncertainties.

The crew selection process is a significant and intensive task, and leaving it to chance may not yield favorable results. It should be managed directly by the yacht owner or entrusted to a professional who understands yachting and private yachts.

One thing is certain; a crew that is competent, qualified, and possesses proper seamanship will tremendously increase not only the value of your yacht but also the enjoyment you receive from it.

So, surrender yourself to a professional crew, live every moment of life to the fullest. Carpe diem!

When acquiring a new yacht, the owners should consider well where to register their vessel at an early stage in the construction or purchase process. The chosen flag state will assign a nationality and an identity to the vessel and provide evidence of ownership, while the rules of the chosen flag state provide the basic operating system for the vessel. The flag also has implications in terms of the vessel's ability to navigate in foreign waters from both a legal and fiscal perspective.

The year 2023 saw some updates regarding registrations. Let's delve into them below.

POPULAR REGISTRIES

THE DELAWARE REGISTRATION

The Delaware registration was mistakenly considered a valid flag for international sailing, often confused as a 'US flag,' though it was merely a 'state' flag and didn't grant US nationality to any vessel flying it. Despite this, many clients were attracted to the flag due to its relatively low cost and the way it was marketed, leading them to believe they were getting more than what it actually offered. In reality, the Delaware registration was only valid if the vessels were kept and primarily used in Delaware.

THE UK REGISTRATION

In light of the issues faced by owners of Delaware-registered vessels, the UK registration emerges as a strong alternative with specific advantages. First and foremost, the UK flag is a non-EU flag, making it essential for Turkish resident clients sailing in EU waters under Temporary Admission. Choosing a Polish flag, an EU flag, might lead to complications, as explained below.

The UK flag allows for direct ownership by a Delaware company, eliminating the need for clients to set up a new company for the registration. This streamlines the process and ensures a smoother transition for vessel owners

Under the UK flag, copy documents are accepted, and the registration remains valid for five years from the date of registration. This convenience saves time and effort for vessel owners. The UK flag is recognized as a proper international flag, allowing vessels to embark on world-wide cruising without the need to visit the UK.

In this case, Turkish clients can choose to register their vessels through companies based in eligible jurisdictions. The options include United Kingdom Company & British Virgin Islands (BVI) Company.

THE BRITISH REGISTER OF SHIPS

The British Register of Ships is a high quality, prestigious and universally accepted register predicated by many centuries of seafaring tradition and maritime history. Crucially, the British Register of Ships has in recent years been at the forefront of the adaptation of international maritime law into substantially equivalent yacht friendly regulations.

The British Register of Ships is divided into several shipping registries who collectively are known as the 'Red Ensign Group'. The Red Ensign Group is made up from the United Kingdom, the Crown Dependencies (Isle of Man, Guernsey and Jersey) and the UK Overseas Territories (Anguilla, Bermuda, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Falkland Islands, Gibraltar, Montserrat, St Helena and the Turks & Caicos Islands). Any vessel registered in the UK, a Crown Dependency or UK Overseas Territory, is a "British Ship" and is entitled to fly the Red Ensign.

MALTA

Malta is one of the most popular EU ports of registry for yachts. Malta has a centuries old Maritime tradition and is well regarded as a leading international maritime service center with many of its rules and regulations adapted from the British registry system.

The sole port of registry under the Malta flag is Valletta. Malta will accept private pleasure yachts of any size and commercial yachts over 15 meters that are based and operated anywhere in the world.

MARSHALL ISLANDS

The Marshall Islands ship registry was expanded in 2001 to enable the registration of commercial and private yachts. The registry benefits from a network of international offices and support from a customer focused client service ethos. For larger yachts, in particular, the Marshall Islands registery has become a well-recognized and highly reputable flag state.

POLAND

Poland has been marketed as a potential flag option in Turkey, offering cost and procedure similarities with Delaware. However, we at Oceanskies have discontinued our 'in-house' Polish flag registration service due to various complications. The process of registering under the Polish flag became increasingly complicated with substantial delays. Clients were forced to wait for weeks for their registration to be completed, causing unnecessary frustration.

Polish flag vessels over 15 meters are now subjected to strict survey safety requirements. Organizing these surveys outside of Poland each year can be challenging and expensive, particularly for larger, higher-value vessels.

A crucial consideration for Turkish resident clients planning to sail in the EU is that Poland's EU flag status disqualifies vessels from Temporary Admission. This means they may need to pay EU VAT, approximately 20% of the vessel's value, if they intend to use the vessel in the EU.

TÜRKIYE

Only Turkish citizens and foreign nationals who have a residence permit in Türkiye are entitled to fly the Turkish Flag. Either registered as commercial or private vessels, both are subjected to 18% VAT. The production of the vessel must be made in accordance with EU norms and there is a CE certificate requirement for registration.

DISCOVERING UNTOUCHED HORIZONS: THE RISE OF EXPLORER YACHTS

SUSTAINED DEMAND: THE ENDURING Numarine continues its steadfast commitment to delivering STRENGTH OF THE YACHT MARKET

Demand has remained strong in the yacht market, with both new and used yacht sales showing resilience in 2022, albeit slightly lower than the previous year. As we move into 2023, there has of the 40MXP model in the year 2023. Renowned for its been a noticeable deceleration in sales, a trend echoed by industry players. However, it is important to contextualize this slowdown within the exceptional performance of the market in 2021 and early 2022. When compared to previous years, such as 2018 or 2019, the current market still stands at a considerably healthier level. Therefore, while there may be a moderation in demand, the overall state of the yacht market remains favorable.

an average of 12 vessels per year, each boasting an impressive length of 30 meters. Despite the recent slowdown in the newly constructed yacht market, the company remarkably achieved sales of 5 units of the 30XP model and 2 units specialized production line, Numarine has ambitious plans to elevate the average boat length to 35 meters while maintaining its exceptional production capacity. Demonstrating keen responsiveness to customer desires, the company persists in refining projects under 50 meters, all the while incorporating cutting-edge technologies into the innovative 30XP model.



HISTORICALLY INDUSTRY...

In 2022, sales of both new and used yachts over 30 meters experienced a decline of 27% compared to the exceptional year of 2021. However, when viewed in a historical context, the results for 2022 are still quite impressive, even ranking among the Top Five best-selling years on record. New yacht sales decreased from 313 to 226, while used yacht sales saw a decline from 506 to 372, marking the second-best result since actively tracking used yacht sales in the mid-2010s. Notably, sales of new yachts in the 30 to 50-meter range were notably lower, and even the prestigious top segment over 80 meters experienced a decline of over one-third.

NAVIGATING THE FLEET

As of the beginning of 2023, the global fleet of superyachts over 30 meters in length stands at 5,555 in active service. Additionally, there are approximately 104 superyachts currently out of service, while around 204 superyachts have been lost since 1945. Motor yachts account for 85% of the global fleet, while sailing yachts make up the remaining 15%. In 2022, a total of 161 superyachts were completed, slightly surpassing the previous year's figure of 156. For 2023, an increase in completions is expected as delayed yachts from 2022 are finalized along with those already planned for this year. However, the number of unsold new-builds that can be pushed to 2023 is very limited. Despite the industry's substantial backlog, the projected growth in completions for 2023 remains modest at 190 yachts. The industry faces challenges in scaling up production due to difficulties in finding qualified staff, the time required for securing or constructing additional production facilities, and pressures on the supply chain.


BUILDING THE FUTURE: CONSTRUCTION BOOK

At the start of 2023, there were 668 superyachts in the construction book, 10% more than in the preceding year when we counted 604 superyachts. The number of yachts actively in-build increased by 74 units to 632, while the number of on hold projects deemed worthy of inclusion in the construction book decreased by 10 units, to 36.

When comparing the current year of 2023 with the previous year, we can observe that Turkey has climbed from the 3rd position in 2022 to the 2nd position in 2023. In 2022, Turkey stood at the 3rd spot after Italy and the Netherlands, but in 2023, it surpassed the Netherlands to secure the 2nd place, coming after Italy.

CONSTRUCTION BY SIZE

An examination of the construction book categorized by length (in meters) reveals that the 40-50-meter segment has made the largest contribution to the expansion of the construction book. There are currently 22 additional yachts under construction in this range compared to the previous year.



YACHT SALES

226 new yachts over 30 metres were sold during 2022, 27% down from 2021's 313 sales. While this drop sounds dramatic, we should keep in mind that 2021 represented an extreme peak in sales and that the sales number of 2022 is still actually very good. The results for 2022 even still make it into the historical Top Five of sales years.

Yacht sales between 30 and 50 metres were considerably lower, while sales in the prestigious top segment over 80 metres also went down by over a third. Meanwhile, sales between 50 and 80 were less affected, dropping by 11%.

30 TO 40-METRE MARKET

New yacht sales in this segment followed the overall market trend, declining by 30% from 71 to 50 sales. Motor yachts went down from 65 to 47 sales while new sailing yacht sales dropped from six to three.

If we look into the composition of the new-build sales we can see that projects started for the client took the largest share with 34 sales, followed by 13 speculation sales and three in-build resales. Like last year, Benetti took the largest share of sales, close to a quarter. The five top selling shipyards in this range are all Italian anyway and together account for 56% of sales

The amount of available yachts in-build is relatively stable in this category. As of the end of 2022, 22 available speculation projects were in-build with planned delivery within the next two years, three yachts more than the year before. Used yacht sales in this segment went down by a third, from 126 to 86, but sailing yachts bucked the trend, going up from five sales in 2021 to nine in 2022.

HISTORIC DEVELOPMENT AND FORECAST

New yacht sales during 2022 continued to be strong, but they did not reach the dizzying heights of 2021, and were 28% lower at 226 sales. The used yacht sales market slowed down by a similar percentage to 372 sold yachts. Average pricing per used yacht was up by about a fifth while average pricing per GT rose by 15%.

The inventory of available used yachts for sale declined further during 2022 and better pricing has not encouraged more owners to list their yachts for sale. Likely because if they sell their yacht, it will be difficult to replace it with an attractive yacht at a reasonable price. Quite a few yachts were also withdrawn from the market for this reason it seems. It remains to be seen whether or not 2023 will bring much of a change to the supply side. Demand certainly seems to be going down slowly as potential buyers appear to be discouraged by the lack of attractive yachts offered for sale. As one senior broker confided to us in early 2023: "The market is slowly cooling and there are no good boats left to sell!"
